
Luxury Private Tour with Dutch/Flemish guide through Kruger Park - Panorama Route - Swaziland - St.Lucia - Durban - Drakensberg Mountains



We take you with us on this 14-day private trip, through the most stunning landscapes to show you the many different faces of beautiful South Africa...

From exciting jeep safaris in Kruger Park to wetland safaris in St. Lucia, and from tropical beaches on the Indian Ocean to breathtaking views in the Drakensberg Mountains.

All this in a comfortable vehicle and you have all the ingredients for an unforgettable journey.



DaY 1 Graskop Upon arrival in Johannesburg, we take a drive to Graskop, with a first stop in Pilgrim's rest, a colorful museum town which attracted a wave of gold diggers in 1873. Hoedspruit Day 2 Today we explore the Panorama route. We start with the Gorge lift, a glass elevator that descends 51m into a tropical rainforest. We visit beautiful sites such as God's Window, the Lisbon waterfalls, the Bourcke Luck Potholes where the Blyde River and the Treur River meet, and the Three Rondavels, the most scenic lookout point over the canyon. We continue via the Abel Erasmuspass and through the Hans Strijdom tunnel for 2 nights in a beautiful wild life estate between the Blyde River Canyon and the Kruger National Park. Day 3 Hoedspruit Today we spend our first full day in the Kruger National Park, the largest and oldest game park in South Africa (+/- 20,000km²). We drive towards Satara and follow north via the Olifants River. If the booking is with more than 4 people, all game drives in the Kruger Park will be conducted in an open car with a ranger, if we're less than 4p we do this with our own 4x4 car. Day 4 Hazyview In Hoedspruit we embark on a cruise on the Blyde River Canyon, the third largest canyon in the world, and in the afternoon we visit Moholoholo Wildlife rehab center. Hazyview Day 5 Full day in the Kruger Park. The Kruger Park has an impressive animal species inventory: 150 mammals, 507 bird species, 33 amphibians, 114 reptiles and 50 fish species have their home base right here. Day 6 Malelane Full day in the Kruger Park. We drive in an interesting area due to the presence of the Sabie River,

which still supplies water to the numerous animals during dry periods.

Last full day in the Kruger Park.

This is a completely different area than the first days; not so vast, many more greens and trees and mountains everywhere, we explore the entire Southern area.

After breakfast we drive on to the Kingdom of "eSwatini" Swaziland, and do a crossing towards St.Lucia, we sleep in a guesthouse or lodge near the Pongola Dam.

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St.Lucia

After breakfast we head out to Saint Lucia, once we have arrived there we embark on a boat trip at the Isimangaliso Wetland Park in search of hippos and Nile crocodiles.

You choose between a guided walking safari (+/- 2/3 hours), or a snorkel safari (+/- 6 hours),

or you might prefer to swim in the warm waves of the Indian Ocean.

We end the day with a 2-hour night safari,

which departs at 8 p.m.

Day 11



Durban

Today we visit Durban, the city with the most Eastern influence of South Africa.

In the afternoon we embark on a whale/dolphin cruise.

We sleep on the beach, right on the Golden Mile.

Bergville

We travel to the Drakensberg Mountains, another highlight of our tour. We spend 2 nights in a resort in Bergville, in the heart of the Drakensberg Massif, overlooking the

Day 14

After an excellent breakfast we drive back to Johannesburg where we unfortunately end our trip with a return flight to Belgium.
