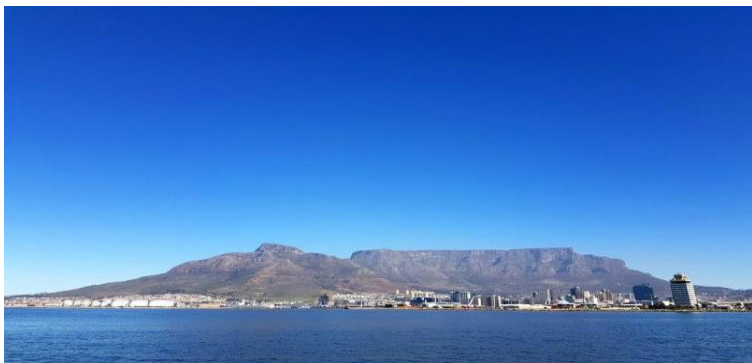




# 15 Days Tour South Africa

Day 1



Graskop

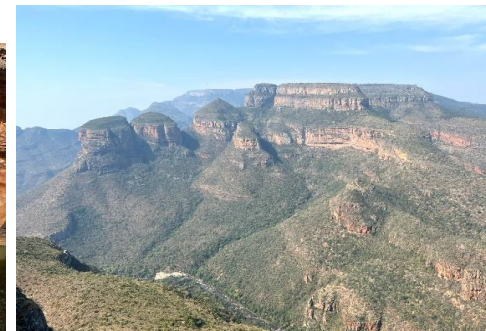
Flight to Johannesburg + drive to Graskop .  
With stop in Pilgrim's rest.

Day 2



Lindanda Lodge , Hoedspruit

Today all day Panoramma route, we start with the Gorgelift, a glass elevator that descends 51m to a tropical rainforest . We visit beautiful views like the : God's Window ,lisbon waterfalls , Bourcke Luck Potholes where the Joyful River and the Treur River meet, and the Three Rondavels, the most scenic lookout point over the canyon. We continue via the Abel Erasmuspass and through the Hans Strijdom tunnel for 2 nights in a wildlife estate between the Kruger National Park and the Blyde River Canyon.



Day 3



Lindanda Lodge , Hoedspruit

In Hoedspruit we visit Moholoholo Rehab center , where injured wild animals are cared for, then we do a cruise on the Blyde River Canyon, the third largest canyon in the world.



Day 4



Hazyview Cabanas

Today we start with a full day in the Kruger National Park, the largest and oldest game park in South Africa (+/- 20,000km<sup>2</sup>). we drive towards Satara and follow north via the Olifants River. This area is known as the cat area.

Day 5



Hazyview Cabanas

Full day in the Kruger Park .  
The Kruger Park has an impressive animal species inventory : 150 mammals , 507 bird species , 33 amphibians , 114 reptiles and 50 fish species have their home base there.



Day 6



Hazyview Cabanas

Full day in the Kruger Park .  
We drive in an interesting area due to the presence of the Sabie River that in dry periods still continue to supply water to the animals.





Day 7



Rio Vista Lodge , Malelane

Full day in the Kruger Park.

We drive to Lower Sabie Camp on the Sabie River and the Lower Sabie Dam .

The area has beautiful lawns and plenty of game in the area .



Day 8



Rio Vista Lodge , Malelane

Last full day in the Kruger Park.

This is a completely different area than the first days not so vast,  
much more wooded and mountains everywhere , we do the entire Southern area .



Day 9



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

After breakfast we leave the East of the country and leave  
we head to Johannesburg for a flight to Cape Town where we  
continue our journey.



Day 10



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

We start in Cape Town with a visit to one of the 7 world wonders of nature  
"Table Mountain", the views are breathtakingly beautiful.

The "Bo-Kaap" also called Cape Malay is a beautiful neighborhood, recognizable  
by its brightly colored houses and spicy exotic scents that the restaurants and  
spreading shops.

Near the city gardens is "the Slave Museum" where you can learn more  
comes about slavery , and apartheid .

The oldest building in South Africa, "Castle of Good Hope", this historical monument  
offer a reminder of how people used to live in Cape Town .

We will visit the Green Market in the center and we will finish in the V&A Waterfront,  
a typical cozy harbor with nice restaurants, pubs and beautiful shops.



## Day 11



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

You have an interesting and nicely filled day ahead of you, because today we will take you along the Cape Peninsula on the "Peninsula Tour".

We start in the coastal town of Hout Bay where we sail by boat to Duikereiland, a rock formation to snorkel among the hundreds of fur seals that make their home there.

We drive further along Chapman's Peak, a scenic mountain pass connecting Hout Bay with Noordhoek and one of the most beautiful coastal roads in the world. We drive on via the rugged coast to the most South-western tip of the African continent, Cape Point, where the Indian and the Atlantic Ocean meet. We offer the possibility to take a walk there enchanting views across the ocean and mountains to the Cape of Good Hope.

Our next stop is Boulder Beach , a beach near the village of Simons Town .

However , this is not just any beach , it is home to more than 2000 black - footed Penguins .

The way back takes us past the picturesque coastal village of Kalkbaai and Muizenberg, the latter is a real surfer's paradise.



## Day 12



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

Today we visit the slums, because this is also part of daily reality in South Africa. The 'Township Tour' starts in District 6, where we follow a short explanation about the history of this district, where thousands of people escaped during Apartheid houses were evicted. Then we drive on to Langa, the oldest slum in Cape Town.

We do this tour in collaboration with a local organization, managed by people who are themselves in the Townships live. This way we get to know the residents and visits much more intensely we see some of their employment projects.



## Day 13



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

Today we start with a walk in the old town center of Stellenbosch and we visit the museum.

We have finally arrived in the Boland, this region is also called the Winelands, and features many green fertile valleys and rich vineyards.

We visit different wine farms to admire , enjoy and taste .



## Day 14



African Palm Cottage , Durbanville

a visit to Franschhoek, a stylish village with a wide range of elegant shops and restaurants and several internationally renowned wine farms is an excellent way to enjoy your last day .
