During this 9-day luxury tour we visit 2 private parks for exciting safaris and above all that, 3 full days in the National Kruger Park.

We also tackle the Panorama Route, the most beautiful South-African route by car, which is filled with amazing views through breathtaking nature.

An unforgettable trip for young and old.



Day 1

Graskop

After arriving at Johannesburg Airport we immediately head towards Graskop, but on our way we stop and visit Pilgrim's Rest, a typical mining village that can still be admired in its original state.

Day 2

Casart Game Lodge , Phalaborwa

Today we discover the Panorama route. We start with the Gorgelift, a glass elevator that takes you down 51m into a tropical rainforest. We enjoy the most beautiful views from sites such as God's Window, Lisbon waterfalls, Bourcke Luck Potholes (where the Blyde River and the Treur River meet) and the Three Rondavels, with the most amazing view over the canyon. We continue via the Abel Erasmuspass and through the Hans Strijdom tunnel for 2 nights in a luxurious private lodge.

Day 3

Casart Game Lodge , Phalaborwa

Casart Game Lodge is located in Grietje Nature Reserve, which has an open connection with the Kruger National Park.

We'll experience our first safari with a ranger in an open vehicle here.

Day 4

Moho

Moholoholo Forest Camp

Our first full day in Kruger National Park.

Kruger NP is the largest and oldest game park in South Africa (+/- 20,000km²).

We drive towards Satara and head towards the North via the Olifants River,

an area known for its enormous presence of cats.

We spend 2 nights in the private park Moholoholo Forest Camp.

Day 5

Moholoholo Forest Camp

We conduct another game drive in an open 4x4 vehicle, guided by a ranger, and we visit the Moholoholo Wildlife Rehab Center.

It's a unique experience to see how injured wild animals are cared for here.

Day 6

Hazyview

Before we leave this impressive private park, we enjoy one more morning walk in the bush, guided by an experienced ranger. After lunch we embark on a cruise on the Blyde River Canyon, which is the third largest canyon in the world. We spend the next 2 nights near Hazyview.

Second day in Kruger National Park.

The Kruger NP has an impressive animal inventory;

150 mammals, 507 bird species, 33 amphibians, 114 reptiles and

50 species of fish have their home base there.

We drive through a very interesting area thanks to the presence of the Sabie River, which even in the driest periods of the year, continues to provide water for all animals.

Day 8



Malelane

Last day in Kruger National Park.

This area is completely different from what we've seen in the previous days. We now evolve into much more forested areas with mountains everywhere. This is Kruger NP's Southern area. We drive towards Lower Sabie Camp on the Sabie River and the Lower Sabie Dam. This area is characterized by beautiful green lawns and lots of wildlife.

Day 9

Unfortunately our trip ends here, and we have to take you to the airport to catch your flight. All beautiful things come to an end, but it's certain that you will enjoy the memory of your wonderful journey through South-Africa for many years to come.
